Drives each lap confidently and consistently on-line										
Exhibits smoothness and complete car control										
Uses ocular vision to properly & safely enter/negotiate corners										
Understands the benefits of and utilizes heel and toe braking/downshifting										
Deliberately deviates from the standard line when necessary (late pass, rain line, etc.)										
Demonstrates lap recall - able to remember/discuss specific areas for improvement immediately after a run group session										
Capable of recognizing how close the car is to its cornering potential for any corner										
One of the faster, yet fully under-control, drivers in the group										
Exhibits patience, courtesy and maturity when following slower vehicles										
Good judgment when encountering unexpected events (i.e., debris, incidents, etc.)										
Understands basic problems such as over/understeer, and how to correct them
